



The Universities/Colleges/Institutions will link the data of the awardee with the master data on the UGC web portal with unique Maker/Checker Ids which have already been provided to them along with the passwords. The Universities/Colleges/Institutions shall update the information in the master data (regarding monthly payment confirmation, HRA, up-gradation, resignation etc.) of the beneficiaries on monthly basis. Based on the data updated on UGC web portal by the concerned Universities/Colleges/Institutions, the payment of the fellowship will be made to the beneficiaries (Detailed process available at https://www.ugc.ac.in/ugc_notices.aspx?id=2153).

It may also be noted that UGC has proposed to link "AADHAAR" with bank account of students so that there can be direct cash transfer and effective disbursal of fellowship into bank account of the student. 



We are pleased to inform that you have qualified Biotechnology Eligibility Test (BET) 2022 under Category-I and you are eligible for the award of DBT – Junior Research Fellowship (DBT–JRF) by the Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Government of India. This Award Letter is being issued to you for activation of fellowship under DBT-JRF programme. General terms and conditions governing the DBT – JRF fellowship are given below:

- Admission to Ph.D. Programme: Fellowship shall be tenable at any recognized host university/ institution in India, where the
 candidate registers for Ph.D. programme. Admission procedure shall be as per the rules and regulations of the host university/
 institution. While considering the fellowship appointment, original documents related to the eligibility criteria and caste/category (if
 applicable) of the candidate must be verified by the appointing authority of the host university/ institution.
- 2. Tenure of Fellowship: Total tenure of fellowship shall not exceed five (5) years from the 'Start Date' of fellowship including the tenure of fellowship awarded by any other funding agency/institution. 'Start Date' of fellowship shall be either the date of joining the Ph.D. programme or date of issuance of award letter, whichever is later. 'End Date' of fellowship shall be either date of completion of five (5) years of fellowship tenure or date of Ph.D. viva-voce or date of resignation by fellow or cancellation of fellowship by DBT, whichever is earlier. On completion of two (2) years as 'DBT-JRF', fellow shall be considered for upgradation as 'DBT-SRF' depending on assessment of the satisfactory progress of the fellow.
- 3. Process for Fellowship Activation: Candidate can activate fellowship on joining a Ph.D. programme. Candidate who is already enrolled for Ph.D. programme, can activate the fellowship on receipt of the award letter. For fellowship activation, candidate must register on DBT-JRF Online Portal www.dbtjrf.gov.in and follow the detailed process for registration of host university/institution, confirmation of Ph.D. guide/supervisor and submission of requisite documents. On verification of the above, fellowship shall be activated under DBT-JRF programme.
- 4. Timeline for Fellowship Activation: Candidate must submit requisite documents for activation of fellowship on online DBT-JRF portal within two (2) months of Joining the Ph.D. Programme. In case, there is a delay in submission of documents by the candidate beyond two (2) months from Joining the Ph.D. Programme, then date of upload of documents on online DBT-JRF Portal shall be the Start Date of fellowship.
- 5. Emoluments under Fellowship: Fellow shall be designated as 'DBT-JRF' with consolidated fellowship of Rs. 31,000/- per month and contingency grant of Rs. 30,000/- per year. Fellow shall be eligible to avail House Rent Allowance (HRA), if institutional accommodation is not provided by the host university/ institution. Fellowship, contingency and HRA (if applicable) shall be released on timely submission of prescribed documents on online DBT-JRF Portal.
- Compliance with Guidelines: Issuance of this award letter and activation of fellowship does not guarantee the emoluments under the fellowship and this award shall be subject to compliance to the DBT-JRF Programme Guidelines as applicable from time to time.
- 7. Validity of Award Letter: Validity of this award letter shall be for two (2) years from the date of issuance of award letter for activation of fellowship, beyond which the validity of this award letter shall lapse.

Subject:- Award of Research Fellowship to Miss Toyeeba Hassan Mir, SRF on the Research fellowship project entitled "Association of CYP 1a2 and CYP 3a4 Gene Expression of Acute Lymphocytic Leukaemia (ALL) in relation with Pesticides".

Sir.

The Director General, ICMR sanctions Research Fellowship to Miss Toyeeba Hassan Mir, SRF on a stipend of Rs. 28,000/- p.m. to carry out research on the project mentioned above, under your guidance. H.R.A. and Medical reimbursement will be paid as per rules of your University.

The award of SRF will be subject to the following terms and condition:

TENURE: It will be tenable for one year only from the date of joining duty and will be on yearly basis subject to maximum of **three years**.

Its continuance will, however, depend on the satisfactory progress of work and can be terminated at any time on a one month's notice, if the progress is not satisfactory, or on receiving adverse report from the Guide. The Fellow will be required to work on the project for a period at least one year.

The event of his/her leaving before completing one year on the fellowship, he/she may be required to refund the stipend drawn by him/her from the date of joining to the date of leaving the fellowship.

PRIVATE PRACTICE: Private practice of any kind, or taking up any appointment even in an honorary capacity during the fellowship is not permitted.

<u>ADMINISTRATIVE CONTROL</u>: The candidate will be under the administrative control of the Institution where he/she works, and will also be subject to the rules and regulations of the Institute.

LEAVE: Leave will be admissible according to the rules of the Institution, however in the case of female research fellows leave without stipend upto 6 months (in lieu of maternity leave) may be granted. No other kind of leave (such as sick leave) etc. will be admissible. Awardees are not entitled to vacation normally admissible to the staff of an Institution.

HRA: HRA will only be paid, if the fellow is not availing any hostel facility. A certificate to this effect should be sent along with joining report for payment of HRA.

REPORTS: The awardee shall submit 1st annual reports for the first 10 months on the prescribed standard proforma.

The first annual report should be submitted after 10 months from the date of commencement of the fellowship giving complete factual details of the research work done through the Guide alongwith his/her appraisal. Subsequent annual report should be submitted through the Guide two months

before the completion of fellowship tenure. Failure to submit reports in time may lead to termination of the award. Six copies of the final report in the prescribed form clearly shall be submitted one month before the date of termination of the award.

A list of the papers published or presented at Scientific Conferences during the tenure of the fellowship should also be furnished with the annual and final reports.

<u>PUBLICATION OF PAPERS</u>: Prior permission for publication of papers based on the research work done during the tenure of the award should be obtained from the Council. The paper should be sent to the Council through the Guide with his/her recommendations. Due acknowledgement to the Council should be made in these papers.

<u>PAYMENT OF FUNDS</u>: The stipend and the funds for contingencies shall be paid as per procedure laid down in the enclosed an annexure.

CONTINGENT EXPENDITURE: An annual contingent grant of Rs. 20000/- p.a. will be admissible. The contingent grant is given to meet petty expenditure for purchase of chemicals, reagents etc. No non-expenditure article or equipment can be purchased out of the grant.

TRAVEL:-

Traveling allowance will not be admissible for joining duty or on termination of the award.

The Council may approve tours of research fellows/associate for:-

- 1. Attending symposium/seminar/conference provided the fellow/associate is presenting a paper which has been accepted by the organizers of the symposium/seminar/conference.
- 2. Field work connected with research
- 3. TA/DA would be admissible as per the rules applicable to Central Government Officers with basic pay equivalent to the amount of the fellowship stipend.

NOTE:- The expenditure on this account will be met

POST FELOWSHIP CARRIER:-

- The Research Fellow can register himself/herself for postgraduate qualification and to utilize in his/her the work done by him/her during his/her fellowship tenure. A copy of these submitted for postgraduate degree will have to be sent to the Council for information and record from the contingent grant sanctioned to the fellow. Due acknowledgement to the ICMR should be made in the thesis by the research fellows.
- 2. The Research Fellow should also send to the Council for information a brief report on the post/job taken by him/her after the expiry of the fellowship.

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
